Camping Conduct Guidelines & Regulations

Please read and agree to the following guidelines:

- **Completed Camper Registration Required by Date on the Form**

Completed camper registrations are required by the specified date on the registration form. No site will be reserved without a completed camper registration or receipt of payment in full. Special requests will not be guaranteed but will be carefully considered and **MUST** be made the Wednesday before the fair begins.

- **Limited Camping Site Resources**

Please understand the Orleans County Fair does the best it can with the resources available. Campers are required to choose between the use of a slide out or an awning to allow room for everyone that would like to stay at the fairgrounds during the fair. Camper dimensions are required in advance as sites vary in width and depth and we must have an understanding of the camper to make camper parking easier for everyone.

- **When to Bring Camper to Fairgrounds**

Saturday and Sunday prior to the fair - 8:00 a.m. - 2:00 p.m.

Monday and Tuesday the week of the fair - Anytime

During the fair – call the main office to ensure road and camping site are clear

If these time frames do not work, you **MUST** call the Camping Coordinator to coordinate an arrival time.

- **Camping Site Conduct**

- Only animals included on livestock forms are allowed on the fairgrounds during the fair. Other pets, including dogs, are **NOT** allowed.
- Secure all valuables. Orleans County Fair is not responsible for property loss, theft or damage.
- Quiet hours are from 11:00 p.m. until 7:00 a.m.
- Campfires are **NOT** permitted.
- Only one vehicle is allowed next to each camp site. Keep vehicle pass in your vehicle window.
- Please keep your camping site organized and clean.
- Alcohol should not be consumed in areas of the fairgrounds other than the beer tent. Alcohol may only be consumed by those 21 years of age or older.

- **Camper Departure**

- Campers must be removed from camp sites by the Wednesday after the fair. A fee may be assessed if campers are not removed.
