DIVISIONS

- **Miniature/Small Pony** - Registration papers not required.
- **Adult** - 19 and over as of Jan 1.
- **Youth** - 18 or younger as of Jan 1.
- **Green Horse** - horse in its 1st or 2nd year of showing. W/T only.
- **Adult W/T** – Open to W/T riders 19 and over as of Jan 1.
- **Youth W/T** – Open to W/T riders 18 or younger as of Jan 1.

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

1-6	➤ Shown in hand. The patterns will be posted the morning of the show.
7	➤ Model class for minis and small ponies
8&9	➤ Model Western or English. You must CHOOSE ONE OR THE OTHER . No minis or Small ponies.
10	➤ Mini and small ponies will all be on the rail in hand and will be asked a series of commands. ➤ Will be judged on how accurately commands are executed.
11&12	➤ Lead line is open to young riders to be lead by a competent handler. ➤ Walk with some trot/Jog ➤ <i>Riders under 5</i> must have a side spotter walking with them during the classes.
18	➤ Open Discipline Rail (Adult, Youth) ➤ At the judge's discretion you will be asked a task while working the rail. ➤ Examples may be backing, side pass, turn on haunches or forehand, halt, extension or collection of gaits, walk on long rein etc.
19	➤ W/T Discipline Rail (Green, Adult W/T, Youth W/T) ➤ At the judge's discretion you will be asked a task while working the rail. ➤ Examples may be backing, halt, extend or collect gaits, walk on long rein etc. ➤ No canter or lope in this class.
25	➤ W/T Road Hack (All Seats) (Green, Adult W/T, Youth W/T) ➤ Walk, Trot/Jog, extend Trot/Jog ➤ No Canter or lope in this class.
26	➤ Open Road Hack (All Seats) (Adult, Youth) ➤ Walk, Trot/Jog, extended Trot/Jog, Canter/Lope, Hand Gallop
27	➤ W/T Horsemanship Pattern (All Seats) (Green, Adult W/T, Youth W/T) ➤ Open to all riders in the W/T divisions. ➤ Pattern to be posted.
28	➤ Open Horsemanship Pattern (All Seats) (Adult, Youth) ➤ Open to all riders in the W/T/C divisions ➤ Pattern to be posted.
29	➤ \$\$\$ W/T Savvy Stakes (All Seats)\$\$\$ (Green, Adult W/T, Youth W/T) ➤ Equitation class with Q&A following ➤ No canter or lope in this class. ➤ 1 st 50% payback, 2 nd 25% payback, 3 rd 5% payback
30	➤ \$\$\$ Open Savvy Stakes (All Seats)\$\$\$ (Adult, Youth) ➤ Equitation class with Q&A following ➤ 1 st 50% payback of entries, 2 nd 25% payback, 3 rd 5% payback
31	➤ Hunter Hack Cross Rails (Adult, Youth) ➤ Open to riders in an <i>English Saddle and English style bit</i> . ➤ Western riders may change tack if they want to participate. ➤ Riders will be asked to W/T/C as in a regular flat class. ➤ Riders will then be asked to jump 2 cross rails individually. ➤ Class is judged 50% on Flat and 50% over cross rails. ➤ <i>The class will only run if at least 3 exhibitors have entered.</i>



CHAMPIONSHIPS

Horse/Rider combo may only strive for ONE championship division.

Circle your choice on your entry form.

MINIATURE/SMALL PONY: 1, 7, 10

ADULT: 2, 8 or 9, 13, 18, 20, 26, 28

YOUTH: 3, 8 or 9, 14, 18, 21, 26, 28

GREEN HORSE: 4, 8 or 9, 15, 19, 22, 25, 27

ADULT W/T: 5, 8 or 9, 16, 19, 23, 25, 27

YOUTH W/T: 5, 8 or 9, 17, 19, 24, 25, 27

GENERAL INFORMATION

HOLDS will be held to a minimum and be a maximum of 3 minutes. You may choose one championship division.

If you are showing a **GREEN HORSE** you are not eligible for any other division on that horse.

Youth and Adult W/T exhibitors may not Canter/Lope ANYWHERE on the grounds.

You may only show in one Model Class.

The county fairgrounds can be busy and fast paced. Please be safe and use common sense.

NO HORSE or PONY may be kept in or tied to a trailer overnight.

Stall requests may be mailed in the same envelope but please use 2 separate checks!

Camper requests should be done through the Orleans County Fair. Please see the website.

Any rider under 18 years old must wear a properly fitted equestrian helmet which carries a current ASTM/SEI approval with secured chin harness properly fastened at all times when mounted. Use of helmets by all riders is highly encouraged.

You must provide proof of negative coggins test and rabies vaccine within the last year to show.

We are NOT affiliated with any other shows at the fair.

Be prepared to show us your paperwork even if you are showing another day.

ENTER FAIRGROUNDS THROUGH GATE B – PARK STREET

All entries received on or before August 12th will have 2 gate passes at Gate B for them.

Gate passes do not include amusement rides.

If you do not Pre-Enter you will PAY AT THE GATE!
